

SUMMER SCHOOL ON “DEMOCRACIA E DESENVOLVIMENTO” ORGANIZED BY THE “ALVES FARIAS” UNIVERSITY (BRAZIL) AT THE UNIVERSITY OF SIENA FROM THE 6th TO THE 17th OF JULY 2015

The “Faculdades Alfa-Alves Faria” University (Brazil), in collaboration with the DIPEC (University of Siena), will hold in the period from the 6th to the 17th of July 2015 a summer school on constitutional law for students, PhD students, researchers and legal professionals.

The course on “Democracia e Desenvolvimento” will focus on the recent trends of constitutional law, with particular attention to the globalization of law and the dialogue between different legal systems.

The summer school will last 10 days and will be divided in 4 different modules. All the classes will treat the different subjects with a comparative approach and will consist of lectures, seminars and discussions on practical cases. The topics proposed to the students will focus on the judicial protection of fundamental rights, civil and political rights, social rights and on the relation between law and economic development.

All lessons will take place in the classrooms of the Law Department of the University of Siena and will be held in Portuguese and Spanish by European and Brazilian professors and experts. The summer school will be managed by Prof. Tania Groppi and Prof. Andrea Pisaneschi for the University of Siena and by Prof. André Ramos Tavares and Prof. Thiago Matsushita for the “Faculdades Alfa-Alves Faria” University.

The summer school will have the main goal of providing to the students who will take part to the classes a knowledge of the juridical systems of the European and the Latin American countries and an analysis of the responses given by the different systems to the recent trends of constitutional law.
